PRESENTATION & ORGANISATION

The “Ecole Nationale Supérieure Maritime” includes four schools:

- Two (Le Havre and Marseille) have been offering, for forty years, an academic syllabus preparing students to a master degree giving a dual diploma, Captain and Chief Engineer. Today, these schools start offering syllabi for the shore side of the maritime industry, port management, shipowning economics, environment... Le Havre will soon offer a deck officer syllabus partly in English in order to facilitate student exchange with other maritime academies.
- One (Nantes) offers a professional syllabus intercalating periods at school and periods at sea as a deck officer, up to Captain (unrestricted) level.
- One (Saint-Malo) offers a professional syllabus intercalating periods at school and periods at sea as an engineer, up to Chief Engineer (unrestricted) level.
